

## Seventh IACM Conference 2022

### CONCURRENT SESSIONS – CALL FOR PAPERS

The afternoon of Friday 24<sup>th</sup> (third day of the Conference) will be dedicated to the presentation of shorter papers by the participants, in sessions held simultaneously

The purpose of these sessions is to give the opportunity to IACM members and all participants to enrich each other by sharing their research, and also to enable the participants to continue the reflection on the theme of the conference, against the background of the main talks, by focusing on specific missionary contexts, challenges and issues.

Each session will feature three paper presentations, each lasting 30 minutes, followed by a further 30 minutes for discussion. The number of simultaneous sessions will depend on the number of participants who will apply to give a presentation. As much as possible, for each session the papers will be chosen that have a similar theme or focus.

To prepare for the session and ensure that they happen smoothly and effectively, we are asking those who would like to give a presentation, to apply by sending a paper proposal by 15<sup>th</sup> May (same deadline as the conference registration).

The proposal will be examined by the concurrent sessions organizing committee for approval.

- b) Priority will be given to papers that relate more closely to the overall theme of the Conference
