Dear Friends of the International Association of Catholic Missiologists,

Warm greetings from Treviso (Italy), my hometown.

Fr Rocco Viviano, our outgoing excellent Executive Secretary, informed you that the seventh Plenary Assembly of our Association, held at the Gregorian University in Rome last June 25, elected the new Board.

I was chosen as new president. I thank the participants for their trust and support. I am a missionary of the Pontifical Institute for Foreign Missions (PIME) and I have been serving in Greater China for nearly thirty years. I believe our Association has great potential for development in the field of missionary studies and reflection. We also would like to have members that are really conscious of participating in the Association, and willing to actively contribute to it.

We will also promote communication and exchange among ourselves, with ecclesial institutions and the general public. The webpage and other social communications will be vital for an International Association like ours.

As we, Board members are quite busy with other full-time occupations, it might take some time for us to get into the business of running the Association, and learn the related skills, but we will get there.

I would like wholeheartedly thank the outgoing Board: the President Fr Wojciech Kluj OMI, Fr Markus Luber SJ, Fr Rocco Viviano SX and Fr Kevin Hanlon MM. I believe that, under difficult circumstances, they have done an excellent job. It is now out task to continue and develop on their good work.
