As previously announced our next General Assembly will take place in about one year from now.

Here are the details:

Venue: **Divine World Institute of Mission, next to the Divine World Seminary. Tagaytay (Philippines),**

Dates: **from Monday 8th to 13th of February 2027.**

Title: ***Artificial intelligence and the fate of humanity: the challenges for mission in the age of transhumanism/post humanism.***

The speakers include Prof. Agnes Brazal from the Philippines, Mr. Victor Lam from Singapore, Mr. Lawrence Chong from Hongkong, Bp. Samuel Agcaracar, SVD of the Diocese San Jose, and Cardinal Pablo Virgilio David of the Diocese of Kalookan.

IACM members from Africa, Asia, Europe and Latin America have been invited as respondents, moderators and in the roundtable discussions.

The topic covered by the speakers and discussants are: Artificial intelligence and the fate of humanity: a theological approach; AI and its Impact to Humanity; AI in Business and Management, Social life and Geopolitics; AI and Post-Humanism and its Impact in Missiology: New Perspective?; AI, Post Humanism and the Mission of the Church.

We will get back to you more info about the schedule of the next General Assembly. After the first day of arrival (February 8th), the following three days and one half are for the academic program; on the afternoon of the February 11th we will have the election of the new board of IACM. On Friday 12 of February, for those who wish, we propose a cultural exposure and excursion. February 13 is the day of departure.
